TASTING NOTES

This *FIRST* edition of OVID Loc. CIT. is both a singular and classic CABERNET SAUVIGNON. An incredible *purity of fruit* dominates the nose. Behind the MANY LAYERS of fruit are *lovely notes* of tobacco, FLINT and *violets*. The WEIGHT OF THE WINE fills the *palate* and makes a *LUXURIANT* IMPRESSION that *lasts* and lasts.

Only in *some years* is there *SUFFICIENT* fruit to make Loc. CIT. CABERNET SAUVIGNON, and 2010 was such a year. It was *a cooler vintage* with measured *RIPENING* which yielded *rich, colorful wines* that are *TRUE REFLECTIONS* of where they come from.

A term used in footnotes, Loc. CIT. is an abbreviation of the Latin phrase-
LOCO CITATO, which means “in the place cited” or
FROM THE SAME PLACE. All Ovid wines come from our estate,
and the Loc. CIT. wine comes from A PERENNIALY DISTINCTIVE PART
of the vineyard: *BLOCK CS-LAB*. In citing a work, an *author credits the originator* of an idea. In naming our wine Loc. CIT., we honor and GIVE
CREDIT to this *particular piece* of ground.

To enjoy the 2010 OVID Loc. CIT. wine *young*, we recommend
DECANTING. It will also ABUNDANTLY REWARD cellaring
for 15-20 years.
